CALL FOR MEMBER SYMPOSIUM/WORKSHOP SUBMISSIONS
DEADLINE EXTENDED! SUBMIT BY SATURDAY FEBRUARY 7, 2026

NASOM's Annual Conference is a wonderful opportunity to share your expertise with others who share your interests in medical disorders in pregnancy.

Submissions are now being accepted for a member-led session: Workshop/symposium presented by NASOM members at the 2026 NASOM Annual Conference. The Conference will be held at the Delta Hotel Ottawa Center in Ottawa Ontario on Friday June 5 and Saturday June 6, 2026.

This session will take place on June 6th from 4:15 to 5:15pm

Sessions should meet the following specifications:

- Demonstrate collaboration between multiple institutions and/or specialties (minimum of Ob med and/or Ob med specialist, possibly MFM/Ob)
- Have clearly stated objectives
- Offer evidence based educational content
- We encourage interactive presentation formats that allow for audience participation.
- Session duration: 45 minutes with 15 minutes for questions

Submission template:

- Title (limit 100 characters including spaces)
- List Presenters (minimum 2, maximum 4 faculty, identify lead presenter & moderator)
- Institutional affiliation & specialty for each speaker
- Measurable objectives (limit 500 characters including spaces) using active language such as "Identify, Recognize, Diagnose, Treat, Create"
- Session summary (limit: 2,500 characters, including spaces)
- Session agenda with time specification - state specific timeframes for each segment (see example below).
- Time for questions should be included in the session schedule (25% needed for CME accreditation).

If accepted, the lead presenter/moderator will be expected to adhere to the time frames listed in the submission.

Session Agenda Example:

5 minutes: Introduction of faculty and session goals

10 minutes: Administer interactive questionnaire to assess attendees' experience with [the topic] (alternatively could embed in individual presentations)

30 minutes: Presentation

- *Faculty 1 -Overview and clinical significance of [the topic] – 10 min*
- *Faculty 2- Pregnancy effects of [the condition] – 10 min*
- *Faculty 3 -Management in pregnancy - 10 min*

15 minutes: Questions and Bottom-line conclusions wrap-up

Please note that there will be no reimbursement of expenses nor honoraria for this activity. Presenters must be NASOM members and must register for the annual Conference.

Last Date for workshop submission is **NOW February 7, 2026**
